
Friends of the Rehoboth



Funding

Since 1975, the Rehoboth Beach Public Library has been an Independent Library. As part of the statewide consortium, RBPL has annual contracts with the State of Delaware and Sussex County. These contracts amount to 63% of the budget. 27% is raised by the Friends or library services. This year the library was awarded several grants to supplement the budget. The remaining 6% comes from Rehoboth Beach City.
